CRYPTOLIGHT forwardly placed, traffic and four wide turning for home, came up empty for the drive. RED COYOTE asked to clear soon after the start, slowed pace down early, responded when challenged second turn, continued to vie, could not contain the winner late, came back in game fashion to annex the place. STACHYS well off the early pace, steady advance up the inside to reach the second flight in the final turn, brief wait with a quarter remaining, moved outside, set down, finished willingly to be clear late. STAY PUT off slowly, trailed well back, came six wide out of the final turn, improved position down the middle of the strip. WILD JACOB off the pace, came five wide out of the final turn, lacked a finishing kick. KATE'S MAIN MAN prompted the pace off the inside, moved to challenge early in the far turn, put a head in front soon after, continued to show the way past the furlong marker, also could not match the winner late, outfinished for the place. HEAVENVILLE within striking distance, had little left for the drive.
