Footnotes

PRIME NUMBER broke alertly, set the pace while rating kindly in the run up the backstretch, shrugged off TELEGRAPH HILL midway on the final turn, bumped with the runner up into the lane, edged away from that rival the final furlong under steady handling. CALIFORNIA KID off slowly, moved up to race in midpack, advanced on the leader in the second turn, exchanged bumps with that rival into the stretch, could not match strides the final furlong. TELEGRAPH HILL forwardly placed, pressed the winner from the outside for six furlongs, could not match strides with the top two in the drive, remained comfortably clear of the others. UNION COLORS off the pace and the inside, roused three wide late in the final turn, lacked a significant late response. ILE BE SHREWED outrun in the early going, steered out to be five wide turning for home, also lacked a closing kick in finishing up evenly. WARREN'S CLYDE bothered at the start, trailed most of the way, picked off a couple of tiring rivals long after the issue had been decided. BOOSTER ROCKET broke in, rank, steadied into the first turn, pulled when prompting the issue early from along the inside, gave way in the far turn. HEAVY SURGE four wide through both turns, tired.
