PRADO STRUTTER never far back, ranged up four wide to challenge late in the turn, shook clear, proved best under steady handling. VAL U ME settled off the pace, five wide into the stretch when advancing, slowly getting to winner. FOREVER HOLY moved off the rail, advanced three wide into the stretch, no late punch, lasted show. SATIN FINISH void of early foot, staged a belated rally down the middle part of the strip. PRAIRIE DANCER improved her position while not a threat. GLOWS SPECIAL LADY five wide late in the turn, no late bid. HEAVENLY HINDU set the pace for a half toward the inside, faded. ON FAITH off bit slow, passed tiring rivals. CHOOSE A ROSE pressed the pace for a half, gave way when the real running started. WILLIAMSPORT steadily faded along the inside. LA STAR was always outrun while inside.
