Footnotes

MAISE AND BLUE allowed the pace to go early, saved ground second turn, angled out for the drive, finished well to be in time. SABBATH DAY POINT cleared to the inside, set all the pace, shook clear when straightened for home, caught in the late going. NINA'S PICK void of speed, advanced through traffic in the second turn, dropped to the rail for the drive, finished willingly up the rail to be in time for the show. PRINCESS FALINA closest to the leader from the start, continued to pressure that one into the stretch, fell back, weakened and was caught for the show. DEAREST QUEEN devoid of early foot, passed tiring foes while not a threat for the win. TRESSSEL within striking distance for six furlongs, gave way in the second turn. TAYLOR TOT showed little outside. BOLD N TRUE have nothing for the drive. DRIVING THE ALLEY faded after a half. CHESTNUT WAY finished early.
