HATTER NU NU broke out, split foes early when moving closest to the leader into the turn, took over into the stretch off the inside, increased advantage under token encouragement through the stretch to win ridden out. FUTURE PRIZE vied early, shuffled back toward the inside into the turn, drifted stretch, no match for the winner, held sway for the place. HALF A KISS lacked speed, came five wide into the lane, staged mild rally for the show, outfinished for the place. MARVELOUS PEACE sprinted clear to show the way before a quarter, continued to set the pace through the turn, weakened when headed by the winner entering the stretch. VICTORY GHOST off a step slow, trailed early, showed some belated interest up the rail. FRISKY'S FIRST evenly paced in lacking a late response. PAIGE'S FOREST forwardly placed and outside, gave way. DANCE DANCE SENORA bothered, off slowly, failed to rally. FATHER'S DREAM was never a factor. CONFETTI QUEEN off slowly, raced wide while outrun.
