POR QUE brief steady in some early traffic the opening furlong, continued behind the leaders, blocked late in the turn, eased out for room in upper stretch, finished full of run to win going away and with something left. BIG CAL vied up front three wide in the run up the backstretch, put a head in front then garnered a larger advantage when straightened for home, proved no match for the winner, remained clear for the place. EDPLICIT bumped at the start, void of speed off the inside, continued behind horses through the turn, late run from between foes to earn the show. ST. RAPHAEL (IRE) with the pace from the start, vied between rivals through the turn, had little left in the late going. WISEMAN'S BLUFF broke in, bumped at the start, forwardly placed off the inside, ranged up to briefly challenge five wide turning for home, failed to follow throughout. READY AND WILD set or forced the pace for a half closest to the inside, faltered. CUBFANBUDMAN bothered at the start, was never a threat. SPIRIT UNBROKEN in the second flight along the inside, gave way early in the turn, pulled up lame and was vanned off.
