OUR REVIVAL unhurried for six furlongs, roused on the outside into the stretch, angled out a bit further for room and finished well to win going away midtrack. LOUCILLE'S RISK last away, trailed early, asked for some run backstretch, advanced and took command four wide in the second turn, briefly clear, caught. MOTHER MOLLY BOO advanced off the rail and inside the runner up to challenge, not enough, finished best of the rest. RAGROID also moved closer in the far turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. LITTLERIVERQUEEN chased the leader far turn, dropped inside late in that turn, finished evenly. REMEMBERTHECOWGIRL moved up after a quarter outside, took over, got clear with a half remaining, faltered in the drive. I GOT vied up front early, gave way after a half. SAVANNAH RULES set or forced the pace off the inside for a half and stopped.
