CINNAMON SILK with the pace outside, held a slight advantage into the lane, drove clear in the late going. KARA'S TEE came out a bit at the start, narrowly set the pace inside, could not match the winner in the late going, remained well clear for the place. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF BETTY'S LITTLE BIT AGAINST KARA'S TEE FOR INTERFERENCE AT THE START WAS NOT ALLOWED. BETTY'S LITTLE BIT steadied slightly in traffic early, well back off the early pace, staged a mild rally, up late for the place. SHE'S A DEPUTY TOO lacked speed, came five wide into the stretch, did not have enough in the late going to earn the show. TWEEN settled in the second flight, four wide out of the turn, lacked a late kick. PRISON OF LOVE lacked early speed, improved position while never a threat for the win. BABY SKATES five wide while beginning a mild advance far turn, fanned six wide into the stretch, lacked late kick. SHOWER AQUIFER lacked speed, angled out to be four wide out of the turn, came up empty. THOUGHTFULLY vied up front between foes, gave way. SUNNY'S SOCIALITE broke sharp, early pace, retreated. TONI ZAMORA hit the gate at the start to be slow leaving, remained well back throughout. CALL ME GRACE was never close.
