Footnotes

TOO CHIC off the pace and the inside, closer in some traffic late in the turn, brief wait, steered out entering the stretch for room, roused, finished full of run. GOT A STASH off the pace, closer along the inside late turn, waited into the lane, squeezed through while continuing along the rail, no match winner, clear for the place. RANDOM SUSPECT broke sharp, fell back, advanced four wide into a striking position late in the turn, vied past the furlong marker, could not match the top two late, finished up best of the rest. HUMBLE DELIA broke in, fell back to trail, tapped toward the inside turn, ducked in to brush the rail upper stretch, angled out late and finished up willingly. CORNER THE SUN lacked speed, five wide into the lane, improved a bit, no real threat. REBECCA'S BULL within striking distance, was beginning to tire in midstretch when altered course to the outside, continued to tire. WILD ABOUT SILVER steadied at the start, moved up to vie through a quick opening quarter, continued to contest the issue into the lane, weakened. MADE MY DAY broke in, raced back, passed tiring foes while never a threat. DAWN'S DESTINY five wide trip through the turn, tired in the drive. JINGLE JANGLE TIME away in good order, contested the pace for a half then stopped in the drive. RUN WITHTHE LADIES prompted the early pace and also stopped.
