RUBIETTA allowed the pace to go early, raced in the second flight through the turn off the inside, three wide bid entering the stretch, kicked well clear. CAT'S THEME also behind the leaders toward the inside and well in hand, roused for the stretch moved outside, proved no match for the winner, clearly second best. SEXY ROSE set or forced the pace off the rail for a half, weakened, lasted for the show. BIANGOOD last away, trailed for a half, split foes turning for home, improved position while never a threat for the win. SALTY N SASSY dueled along the inside, gave way in the drive. FASHIONABLE CATON made little impact. MISS ABBY finished early. WELL GO THEN raced outside, faded in a dull effort. WESTERN HONOREE mild middle move, gave way.
