HENRY'S TIME with the pace while off the inside, shook clear in the turn, increased advantage in the drive under steady handling. WHATTHECATDRUGIN forward, between foes when heading up the second flight through the turn, proved no match for the winner drive, well clear of the rest. WHISKEY DECISION off a step slow, raced back and toward the inside, angled out late turn, continued to steer our upper stretch, finished up willingly to be clear for the show. MAIN MANN LEE four wide trip, managed little in the way of a late rally. ROCKET ZONE off the rail, came five wide into the stretch, improved a bit. KILLOQUAH closest to the winner early inside, steadily faded. STRONG FINISH had little for the drive. HIT IT HARD in the second group for a half, backed up through the stretch. BUSYBEINGFABULOUS trailed throughout.
