CHIEF THREE SOX, never far back three wide, challenged into the second turn, put a head in front soon after and steadily drew off. DIXIE ROAD settled off the pace and the inside, could not match strides while clear for the place. DA DEVIL lacked early foot, came five wide into the stretch and finished willingly. DURMIENTE (CHI) went evenly outside. LAFFER narrowly set the pace early, got clear before a half, briefly raced on equal terms with the winner the third quarter then faltered. BATTLE ROYALE, four wide into the first turn, failed to seriously menace. ROBINWOULD, also four wide int he first turn, failed to muster a late bid. TALIHINA tired as did ARCHER COUNTY. TEXAS TUXEDO trailed most of the way.
