TAUM SAUK took over soon after the start, set the pace along the inside, drew out in the drive while under steady pressure. BIG BOY CHARLIE bothered at the start, closer late in the turn, checked in tight quarters turning for home, recovered and finished willingly for the place while toward the inside. KONA KID void of early foot, advanced in the turn, came five wide into the stretch, finished up best of the rest well out in the strip. R FIRST ALEX settled off the pace, raced in hand turn while continuing off the inside, made little impact in the drive. LEVI'S COMING within striking distance, was beginning to fade when forced to check, bounced off the rail late in the turn, continued to back up. BATESVILLE within striking distance, three wide turn, gave way in the drive. READY TO ROLL pressured the winner for a half, faltered. SUPERLAGRA sluggish from the start, pulled up, walked off.
