Footnotes

AKA LILY'S LAD allowed the pace to go early, moved closer in traffic three furlongs out, took over turning for home off the inside, drew comfortably clear. GOLD NINER last away, void of early foot, advanced through traffic second turn, came on the outside for the drive, finished willingly to be up for the place late. TURNLEFTATTHELIGHT settled off the pace, came three wide into the lane, was going evenly late while not a threat to the winner, caught for the place. ALPHA CAPO closest to the leader, took over in the second turn, faltered in the drive while along the inside. LUMBERJACK CAT in second group, checked up behind a rapidly tiring foes in the far turn, fell back a bit, was going evenly in the late going. MUST BE HE completely devoid of early foot, four wide turning for home, passed tiring rivals. PACIFIC STAR settled, tired in the drive. WHISKEY MAN never a threat. ESPERAMOS quickly sprinted well clear after an alert break, stopped.
