Footnotes

SIR JOCK off pace, four wide, outside bid, long drive, edged away in the late going under steady handling. STORMY HIGHLAND behind the pace, in traffic turning for home, waited behind the leaders turning for home, moved out, finished willingly to be up late for the place. RATIFY forwardly placed along the inside, continued in a striking position entering the stretch, got through rail, did not have enough for the place. SILVER WAR pressed the issue early off the inside, vied through the turn in the three path, weakened in the final furlong. PONCIRUS last away, remained back for three furlongs, began to advance in traffic late in the turn, continued to improve through the lane. THATS A GOOD THING lacked speed, came six wide out of the turn when improving position, flattened out in the late going. REWIRING five wide late in the turn when off the pace, lacked a late bid. LEOPOLD BLOOM failed to menace. CRESRAN broke on top, set the pace for a half while just off the inside, stopped in the drive. THREE M EXPRESS was finished after a half.
