ASK AUNT AMBER bumped at the start, recovered, raced within striking distance, challenged three wide into the stretch, drove clear. BEAUTIFUL AND ABLE bumped at the start, lacked speed, came into the lane in traffic, angled out when straightened for home, finished up willingly. GITCHAPOPCORNREADY at the pace, four wide through the turn, went evenly in the drive. PROPER ROYALTY void of speed, swung out five wide for room turning for home, improved position while not a serious threat. HALFDRESSED closest to the leader off the inside, challenged between foes out of the turn, had little left for the drive. A P DILLY last to leave, raced well back for a half, passed tiring foes while also never dangerous. LAURA RACHEL went evenly paced throughout in lacking a winning response. THISHEARTSFORYOU off the pace and three wide turn, tired in the drive. PROUDEST HEART failed to rally. OILVE OIL TOO five wide through the turn, remained back. FARE WEATHER STORM cleared from the outside to set the pace, maintained a daylight advantage through the turn, gave way when headed entering the stretch. SHADOWMAKER sluggish, distanced.
