MARLI'S MAN broke out, bumped start, raced back, advanced five wide through the turn, set down when straightened for home, finished with good late energy to be in time. HAYN DAWG never far back, challenged after racing four wide through the turn, took over, drifted out, then in triggering a chain reaction of interference deep stretch, caught late. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, HAYN DAWG WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM SECOND AND PLACED EIGHTH. SENOR SMILEY bumped start, steadied repeatedly when lacking room in traffic in the run up the backstretch and through the turn, steered out, cut off, forced in a sixteenth out, held third spot. ZARBY'S HOME vied up front, came in the three path when with the first flight into the stretch, bothered, in tight a sixteenth out, finished up evenly. EXPLOSIVE GHAZIE off slowly, raced well back, moved out to be

seven wide out of the turn, displayed some interest down the middle of the strip while too late. MY NEPHEW MATT broke alertly, set or forced the pace just off the inside, between foes when weakening slightly late, steadied in in tight, lost position. CABE bobbed at the start, raced back and between foes, made little impact. ONE TUFF STORM off the pace, ranged up inside to vie along the rail into the lane, was tiring when steadied a sixteenth out, continued to fade. CAPTAIN BILLY bumped at the start, six wide out of the turn, lacked a late kick. POPPAS HALF bothered, bumped at the start, remained back. DONNY'S DEMON off a bit slow, was never close. MCFADDEN pressed for a half, stopped in the drive.
