SHEER JOY back off the pace, moved out, came five wide turning for home, firm handling, proved narrowly best. BLESSED MOON lacked speed, came three wide into the lane when asked, bid between rivals with a sixteenth remaining, vied to the wire, missed. J GRAY forwardly placed while racing outside, crept closer while four wide turning for home, put a head in front nearing the furlong marker, could not contain the top two, saved the show. OUISER void of speed, roused in the two path turning for home, steered out, improved position. EMILY'S SUNDANCE sprinted clear soon after the start, continued to lead by daylight in the turn, weakened when headed upper stretch. KID ROCKETTE off the pace, came five wide into the lane, lacked the needed late kick. GALLOPING DOMINO closest to the leader for a half, gave way. THE BARN MANAGER well off the pace and the inside, floated out to be six wide turning into the stretch, failed to muster a rally.
