HUMBLE SMARTY slight bump at the start, asked a bit late turn, roused for the drive, late bid, could not get by. EXPLOSIVE GHAZIE off the pace, came five wide when advancing into the stretch, along for the show while no match for the winner. MEME'S BOY pressured the winner for five furlongs outside that one, weakened. STORMIN STEVE made little impact while racing toward the inside as he lacked a late kick. SHORTY SMALL void of early foot, angled out for the drive, belated interest midtrack. CHOCTAW BINGO in some traffic late backstretch, failed to rally. CAPTAIN BILLY forwardly placed for a half, backed up in the drive. STORMING INDY bumped at the start,, remained always back. MY NEPHEW MATT tired in the drive.
