TUSCAN MIST outrun in the early going, moved a bit closer along the inside in the second turn, brief wait, got thru rail, moved out when moving smartly late, in time. CODE BLUE broke sharp, got clear, long lead backstretch, continued to show the way late, could not contain the winner. STAR VECTOR chased the pace, had little for the top two in the drive, held the show. TEJANO WHO lacked speed, improved position while never a threat. CURLY CAMELI last away, trailed, showed some belated interest while not a serious threat. FR. DENIS closest to the leader for most of the way, gave way in the drive. SILVER HAZE lacked a late bid. TEZ AZADI failed to rally. RISKY WEATHER began to tire after five furlongs. GOLD TO GO backed up through the stretch.
