Footnotes

GATHER ALL well clear soon after the start, set all the pace while rating, continued to show the way by a considerable margin into the lane, kept to task. WHISTLER'S DREAM well off the early pace, advanced to be nearest that one when turned for home, proved no match in the drive, clearly second best. STARTINGOLD devoid of early foot, trailed outside, finished up best of the rest. LEVI'S COMING settled off the pace while off the inside, had little left for the drive. SON OF TIGER last away, trailed while well out in the strip, managed to improve only slightly. READY TO ROLL closest to the winner for six furlongs, stopped late in the final turn. STAR SPLASH never close, was distanced after losing contact with the field. BLUE HEAT stopped after a half, was also distanced.
