**Footnotes**

FLASHY RAE closest to the leader while racing off the inside, ranged up to challenge the leader in the second turn, extended duel to the wire, fully extended off the inside to prove narrowly best. MISS FEMME FATALE broke best of all, showed the way into the first turn in hand, got clear while under firm restraint before a quarter, responded when challenged midway on the final turn, dueled to the wire, missed. ABBIES MY DADDY saved ground behind the pace, fell back into the far turn, came again for the show while not a threat to the top two. MEAFAREL'S REWARD void of speed while saving ground, moved out when beginning to advance far turn, came four wide into the lane, staged a mild rally to improve position, outkicked late for the show. TETON BEAUTY between foes when with the second group into the far turn, weakened. CLEVER PEAKS broke out, tucked toward the inside to save a little ground into the first turn, never a threat while four wide turning into the stretch. PRINCESS OF POWER in the second flight while racing three wide, had little for the drive. FOREVER GRACE slow to settle, moved out to be four wide and free of traffic in the first turn, pulled up just before a half, vanned off.
