### Footnotes

TAYLOR'S DAY forwardly placed from the start, lodged a bid from between foes into the turn, stretch duel, gained nod. CATNIRO settled off the pace early, challenged on the outside turning for home, long battle stretch, missed. OVERDONE lacked speed, roused from between rivals late in the turn, no late gain. ART TO RAIN fell back to trail after the start, five wide into the stretch, no serious rally. BIG THUNDER steadied in traffic backstretch, came up empty for the drive. FLYING METRO sprinted clear soon after the start, faltered when displaced in the turn. CAT TRACKS got out into the turn, pulled up.
