DIAMOND BAND with the pace while in hand off the inside, put a head in front midway on the turn, continued to show the way past the furlong marker, slowly edged clear under steady handling. MY PRECIOUS INDIAN in the second flight for a half, came four wide into the stretch, brushed foe when straightened for home, finished with good determination to be up late for the place. CALLI RIO broke sharp, set or forced the pace closest to the inside, caught late for the place. WOOD AND MOLASSES fell back on the outside after breaking with the field, never dangerous. STELLAR CLOUD remained back. MY MAINE GIRL off a bit slow, moved up into a striking position, brushed by the runner up in upper stretch, faded.
