BATTLE BRIDGE settled off the pace and the inside, continued to track the pace front along the inside through the second turn, switched out into the lane, set firmly down, proved best under continued spirited handling. FAST BOBBI J back off the pace while three wide, ranged up and took over turning for home, could not contain the winner in the late going. PEDESTRIAN broke in, raced back while saving ground, in traffic in the second turn, moved out, four wide into the lane, staged a modest late gain. LADY HADDASSAH trailed well back, came five wide out of the final turn, flattened out a bit late to finish up evenly. WISH WISH WISH showed the way past the wire the first time, got clear late in the first turn, continued to set the pace up the backstretch and into the far turn, weakened when headed by the runner up turning for home. ILLEGALLY BLONDE in the second flight while four wide in the first turn, continued on the outside, came up empty for the drive. SAGE D'ORO off the pace, steadied with a half mile to run in traffic, four wide turning for home, lacked a late kick. SOUTHERN DRIFTER closest to the leader for five furlongs, gave way.
