Footnotes

QUIET MAN broke with the field, dropped inside to save some ground in the first turn, moved up the rail to put a head in front just before a half, dueled into and through the final turn, edged slowly away the final furlong under steady handling. CONGENIAL showed the way early off the inside, allowed the winner the rail before a half, dueled outside that rival the third quarter and into the lane, could not match strides the final furlong. BELLARMINE one paced throughout, lacked a winning kick in the drive. DOUBLE RAH RAH prompted the pace for six furlongs, had little left for the drive. STEELMAN RUN never menaced. KID SIDNEY also remained always back.
