ON THE FRITZ broke well, with the early pace, got clear just after a quarter, breather in the turn, increased advantage drive under token encouragement. AIR STORM lacked speed, advanced six wide into the stretch, no match winner, clear for the place. YOU LOV RACEY lacked early foot, staged a mild rally while five wide. ICE FOREST four wide in the turn, evenly to wire. MARY URN chased the winner through the turn, weakened final quarter. LITTLE SHON tired after four furlongs. A CHANCE FOR MORE passed tiring rivals. SENSATIONAL CHARM failed to menace. MANY MANY GIRLS flashed brief speed, faded before four furlongs while along the inside. BLACKBERRY raced always back. SILVER MIST last away, never close. NANOCITY finished early.
