ASKEEBOY tucked in to save ground soon after the start while racing far back, advanced while continuing inside, angled out a bit for room under clever handling upper stretch, split foes and drove well clear. JOEPIANO seven wide into the first turn, continued to race on the outside, five wide late second turn, finished willingly to be up for the place. SUSHI JOE forwardly placed, outfinished for the place. JOYFUL JETT lacked speed, came five wide into the lane, improved position. I'M THE DADDY moved toward the inside soon after the start, came six wide when beginning to rally into the lane, stride late. HE'S A YANKEE within striking distance, lodged a mild bid four wide turning for home, hung in the late going. DREAMINGOFTHE SALE six wide into the first turn, lacked a rally. CATTLE BARON vied up front off the inside, gave way in the final furlong. MILWAUKEE HIGH had nothing left for the drive. JUMP COMMANDER vied up front along the inside, stopped. LIL BIT JUMPY four wide in the first turn, tired in the drive. CINNAMON COWBOY within striking distance, backed up bad stretch.
