BET THE POWER moved up to duel soon after the start, shook off the other speed along with a couple of other rivals turning into the lane, rebroke, roused, driving. SEGURO in the second flight off the inside, ranged up to briefly challenge four wide turning for home, proved unable to match strides with the winner through the stretch, clearly second best. ALEX'S VISION in the second group inside of the runner up, moved up briefly three wide and between foes to challenge turning for home, proved no match to the top two, finished up clear of the others. GRAYSONIA alternated up front outside the winner for a half then gave way from between rivals. LOVANGO away in good order, fell back and never menaced. LITTLE CHIEF last away, trailed throughout in showing little.
