Footnotes

BOURBON KING unhurried in the early going, moved a bit closer in the second turn, dropped to the inside when straightened for home, moved out a bit, split foes late, proved best in a game effort. CITIZEN KAT forwardly placed while in hand, asked along second turn toward the inside, moved out, also staged a late bid, outfinished. SACREDSPIRIT away with the field, raced toward the front while firmly in hand, three wide second turn, set down for the drive, lacked a closing punch. AWESOME INTIME sprinted clear soon after the start, set the pace, proved stubborn until late toward the inside. FOLLOWYOURDADDY settled off the pace and the inside, lacked a finishing kick. ZELLERS closet to the leader for six furlongs, gave way in the drive. DENOUEMENT off the inside while rating well off the pace, angled out, six wide turning for home, lacked a rally. MATCHLESS broke slowly, raced well back, not a threat. DOC'S MINE always outrun.
