APPREHENDER bobbled slightly at the start, with the pace three wide, got clear late in the turn while under confident handling, increased advantage when straightened for home, maintained a comfortable margin to the finish under token encouragement. BASALT back off the early pace, three wide into the turn, moved out to be five wide for the drive, no match for the winner, clearly second best. BEWARE THE DEVIL fell back after the start, remained unhurried into the turn, came five wide out of the turn, staged a mild rally to be along for the show. SILVER DANDY forwardly placed, raced in a bit tight between rivals into the lane when with the second flight, lacked a late response, caught for the show. PRYCE'S POSSE vied up front in the early going toward the inside, gave way after four furlongs. MAJORCA SUN raced off the pace in the two path, in hand late turn, shifted out a bit for the drive, failed to rally. J C'S DREAM made little impact while racing three wide. SIR RICHEY last away, trailed throughout.
