ONE MORE WEEK within striking distance on the outside, advanced into the far turn, vied into the lane while between horses, long drive, proved narrowly best in game fashion. SLEEVE settled off the pace, four wide turning for home when moving to challenge, put a head in front when straightened for home, outfinished. BALUARTE asked along out of the gate, showed the way into the first turn, continued to set the pace while rating up the backstretch, vied into the lane, could not match the top two the final furlong, saved the show. SAVIANO forwardly placed along the inside, firmly restrained into the far turn, came up empty for the drive. BARRAAQ settled off the pace along the inside, steered out, moved closer midway on the final turn, four wide into the lane, flattened out. SMITTY'S MOONSHINE lacked speed, was never dangerous. SCARIFF ISLAND was never a threat while racing off the inside. SONG OF LIFE pressured the leader off the inside, gave way in the far turn. LOOKINTOGETOUT off slowly, trailed throughout in showing little.
