Footnotes

CHARGING INDIAN away in good order, dueled from the outset closest to the inside, fully extended in the drive. FINAL DRAFT alternated up front outside the winner and proved stubborn until very late. SMILE AND TEARS chased the top two while off the rail, held the show. CATNOUR void early foot while racing toward the inside, angled out for the drive, improved position a bit while not a serious threat. JOLIE'S THUNDER made little impact. TAKE A SHOT a bit sluggish leaving, raced five wide out of the turn, failed to menace. T. K.'S HONOUR saved ground early in the turn, moved out, was not a factor. GUARDIAN raced in the second flight toward the rail, tired after a half. PARHELION (GER) finished early, far back.
