TRIPLE NINE FINE in the second flight and well off the inside, came four wide into the stretch, proved no match for the winner, well clear of the rest. T. C. CHAMP set the pace off the inside, weakened but managed to hold the show. CALLAHAN outside early, moved in a bit late in the turn, went evenly in the drive. BEST OF THE WEST devoid of early foot, came on the outside into the lane, displayed some late interest well out in the strip after the issue had been decided. WATCHINGGIRLSGOBY in hand early, remained back throughout toward the inside. ORIENTAL STORM broke to the inside, tired. NOBLE SMITH steadied, bothered at the start, moved up, faded in the drive.
