INDIA broke a bit to the outside, took over into the far turn from between foes, showed the way through the second turn, shook well clear stretch, slight drift out, straightened, firm handling, challenged late, dug in the final strides to narrowly prevail. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF THE RUNNER UP AGAINST THE WINNER FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS QUICKLY DISMISSED. KETTLEONEUP fell well back after the start, began to move early in the far turn, circled four wide into contention entering the stretch, drifted steadily in to brush with the winner late, outfinished. A TRUE PUSSYCAT lacked speed, inside advance, switched to the outside midstretch, along for the show while no match for the top two. PLAID unhurried early, lodged a mild middle into contention turning for home, failed to sustain that effort in the drive, flattened out a bit late. GASIA went early up the inside to show the way through the first turn, dueled up most of the backstretch, fell back. CHRISTMAS LILY forwardly placed for six furlongs, stopped in the drive.
