MOTEL TAN outrun in the early going, began a quick move three wide midway on the turn, reached the front entering the stretch, angled in when clear, kept to task. CLIFF'S REIGN pushed in at the start, straightened and raced forwardly inside, moved out for the drive, no match winner, clear for the place. CLEVER PRADO bore in at the start, raced back, switched out when straightened for home, staged a mild rally to finish up best of the rest. JOHNNYESREVENGE dueled up front while off the inside, weakened in the drive. TOUGH MOUNTAIN set or forced the pace along the inside, also faltered after a half. SPRING CHOIR bumped, bobbled at the start, came four wide into the stretch, went evenly through the stretch. SUNDAY DEBUT off slowly, remained back throughout. FRIENDLY FACE forwardly placed and four wide early, began a steady retreat before a half.
