AWESOME TRUTH four wide into the first turn while behind and outside the leaders, continued to stalk in the run up the backstretch, made a nice move four wide in the second turn, gained the advantage and had enough left late to narrowly hold the runner up safe. TWICE AS WISE unhurried in the early going, advanced five wide while behind the winner late in the second turn, set down for the drive, slowly gaining. COUNTRY CAUCUS forwardly placed toward the inside, rated middle half, could not match the top two the final furlong, well clear of the rest. GABBIE GULCH pressured the leader off the inside, between rivals in the second bend, had little left in the final furlong. SHE'S ABOVE DA LAW lacked speed, dropped inside to save some ground, moved out a bit for the drive, improved slightly while not a serious threat. WHY GO WEST lacked speed, 4w into lane, also made little impact down the lane. STONESEZ well back early, swung out to be six wide turning for home, managed little in the way of a rally. TSUNAMI SALLI shuffled back at the start, was never a factor. LOST ACCOUNT brushed in some tight quarters just after the start, sprinted clear to set the pace, stopped when headed turning for home.
