DENALI SILVER broke alertly, showed the way early, larger lead in the turn while still hand, remained clear through the stretch under steady handling. R J'S AFLEET lacked early foot, steered out to be three wide when roused for the drive, finished up willingly late while in some traffic. SARATOGA RED bothered at the start, off the pace, two path into the lane, roused, mild rally up the rail for show, outkicked for the place. BIG SKY within striking distance, came three wide out of the turn, closest to the winner late, caught for the place final strides. GRANDPA GEORGE raced outside and in the 2nd flight, four wide through the turn, came up empty for the drive. MEADOW'S REWARD closest to the winner for over five furlongs, backed up late. WOULD YOU last to leave, never menaced. LANGALEER remained always back. MOSQUILLO broke out to bother SARATOGA RED, raced in the second flight for a half then gave way in the drive.
