D Y N FOR A STAR broke alertly, set the early pace three wide and in hand, disposed of the other speed when straightened for home, kept to task. ZENARO broke out, pressured the winner four wide and from the outside for over a half, could not match strides the final furlong, second best. CONVENTIONAL ducked out at the start, continued outside, five wide into the stretch, mild rally to finish best of the rest. I WISHED in a bit tight at the start, lacked speed, also came five wide out of the turn, was never dangerous in the drive while improving position slightly. PETTY SONG moved up soon after the start to contest the issue up front while between rivals, asked along late in the turn, weakened in the drive. VERITATE was never a threat. SATURDAY'S SECRET with the leaders along the inside, gave way. MILLIONAIRE STORM was finished early.
