BRASSY AND PROUD off the early pace, advanced toward the inside into the far turn, collared the leader in upper stretch, drew well clear under steady handling. STAR AFFIRMED settled in mid pack while racing off the inside, along for the place late while not a threat to the winner. BUNKER'S LEDGE broke on top, well clear the middle half through some lively fractions, weakened in the drive. STATE LINE AVENUE off the pace, four wide when improving through the second turn, went evenly to the wire after flattening out a bit in the drive. GOOBER last away, trailed well back, improved position by passing some tiring rivals. T. THOMAS lacked speed, failed to rally. REDIRON MAN lacked a late kick outside. B B SAMPSON within striking distance while three wide early, faded after a half. STAR SEARCHER closest to the leader for five furlongs, stopped.
