DEVIOUS INTENT sprinted clear soon after the start, set a moderate pace, turned back a brief bid in the second turn, clear again drive. TRANS CONTINENTAL behind the pace toward the inside, lost some position in some traffic into the far turn, moved out to be four wide for the drive, could do little with the winner in the drive, remained well clear for the place. GOLDRUSH GIRL within striking distance toward the inside, lacked a winning response in the drive, narrowly held the show. TOXIS off the early pace, lodged a mild middle move three wide, flattened out in the drive. BWANA BABE closest to the leader while racing outside, continued to chase into the far turn, weakened from between rivals late in that bend. MISS HOCKADAY fell far back after the start, trailed, steered out to avoid a stricken foe early backstretch, was never dangerous. LADY JENSEN failed to menace. YANBIAN EXPRESS fell back after the start, broke down toward the inside early backstretch.
