FLATTERMEJIM allowed the leader to go early, moved off the inside, began to move on that pair under confident handling into the far turn, collared those rivals from the outside turning for home, drew clear, driving. RUNAWAY PEPPER broke best of all, alternated up front closest to the inside, narrowly showed the way into the far turn, could not match the winner in the drive, clearly best of the others. DESTIN TO REIGN settled off the pace, roused three wide out of the final turn, moved out a bit more for the drive, clear for the show, no threat to the top two. STEREO IN MOTION back off the pace, staged a modest gain to improve position, never a serious threat. HARBORPLACE dueled up front off the inside, continued to alternate through the final turn, weakened in the drive. RUNAWAY CRYPTO completely devoid of any kind of speed, remained well back for six furlongs, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while never a serious threat. BOOBY PRIZE settled off the pace, tired in the drive. ROY L. was never close. PACAR closest to the early leaders, stopped.
