SOME CAME RUNNING chased, not enough left in the late going. FUNNY MOOD (ARG) failed to fire in a dull effort. JIFFY WISH trailed for a half, modest late interest. MISS SANTA ANITA lacked a response. KYLERS MIDGE broke sharp, cleared early, stopped when headed.
