ALEXIE outrun early, came six wide into the lane, rallied, up in time down the middle of the strip. MS GIFTED SINGER vied up front four wide into the turn, shook off the other speed when straightened for home, caught in the late going. CAMRYNLEE lacked early foot, made a good gain through the turn, flattened out in the drive, no late gain. BLOWING SMOKE with the pace for a half along the inside, faltered. WHISKEY MISS moved closer five wide turning for home, hung in the drive. ANGELIC LOOK bumped at the start, contested the pace while between foes, weakened the final quarter. GOLDEN BROGAN bumped at the start, vied between foes, gave way in the turn. CHRIS KRIS faded. WENDY MOGAMBO off slow, ducked in at the start, remained back. JAMMIN CORWYN finished early.
