BACK BAY BARON with the from the start along the inside, went quick early, showed the way out of the turn while still in hand, drove clear. MARKET FORCE vied up front while between foes, dueled into the stretch, could not match the winner late, held the place. IFTHESHOEFITS lacked early foot, saved ground through most of the turn, up for the show while continuing toward the inside late. SATELLITE within striking distance, lacked a winning kick. WHEEL MAN off slow, trailed for a half, passed tiring foes. MERCATUS back early, improved position, no real threat. ELUSIVE JOSH within striking distance, had little left for the drive. OUT OF VIEW vied early up front while three wide, began to fade before a half. BORDER AGENT backed up. FEEDLEBAUM gave way in the turn, well beaten.
