MISSISSIPPI MARTINI well off the early pace, ranged up into contention five wide late in the turn, lost ground to the leader entering the stretch, got back to that one late under firm handling, proved best. MYSTERIOUS CHIMES reluctant to load initially, broke well once the race began, set the pace inside, clear a furlong out, caught. SCHOOL LASS broke out, raced well back in trailing, angled out to be five wide exiting the turn, staged a belated rally to be up for the place. KIT CARSON off the pace, moved closer late on the inside late in the turn, boxed, eased out, got through, drifted slightly, flattened out, caught for the show. ROMA JEAN pressured the runner up off the inside and between foes, got out a bit turning for home, weakened. OCEAN MAGIC bothered at the start, made little impact. SHE'S A PIONEER prompted the pace three wide, gave way in the drive. HONEY BUNCH veered in start, unseated rider. THE START WAS DELAYED APPROXIMATELY 24 MINUTES DUE TO AN INJURY TO AN ASSISTANT STARTER.
