ROAD MAN in the second flight between foes, checked up when in tight early in the turn, fell back, moved out, five wide out of the turn, finished with a flourish to be in time. SNOW ON THE BAYOU off the pace, advanced four wide to challenge late in the turn, long drive, missed between foes. DE THRILL dueled up front off the inside, showed way into the stretch, dueled to the wire, outkicked in the final strides. MR. SLATER HANDS broke in slightly, behind the leaders toward the inside, moved up, challenged between rivals turning for home, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. JENNY'S TOUCH bothered slightly at the start, moved up inside to duel, began to weaken late in the turn. SPY in the second group off the inside, in some traffic late in the turn, had little left for the drive. LEE'S SOUTH settled off the pace, had little for the drive. BOSS M ducked into the gap just after the start, remained back and failed to menace. SURF DOCTOR was always outrun. TEMPLE BAR trailed throughout in a dull effort.
