JIFFY WISH void of early foot, began to rally in the second turn, came on the outside into the stretch, finished willingly to be getting to the winner. SOUTHERN SURPRISE chased the winner and had little left in the drive. BOOM BOOM CHA CHA settled off the pace, roused for the drive off the inside, missed the show. MISS LUCKY STRIKE within striking distance, came up empty for the drive. PEYTONS PLEASURE finished after a half. WILD RIDE forward early, steady fade, distanced after losing contact with the field.
