GOLDEN SONATA far back for six furlongs, swung to the far outside for the drive, full of run to be in time down the middle part of the strip. KEYS TO THE HEART back early, raced in the second flight into the stretch, waited briefly midstretch in traffic, no match winner, second best. MAYO ON THE SIDE forwardly placed, came four wide to challenge in the second turn, showed the way past the furlong marker, could not contain the top two. SPECTACULAR LISA forwardly placed, vied three wide in the second turn, not enough in the late going. THERE RUNS HATTIE behind the pace along the inside, improved late while continuing up the rail. SMALL PROMISES set or forced the pace inside, weakened. MY TRUSTY CAT contested the pace while between foes, faltered. LA REASON five wide in the first turn, ranged up again to be five wide in the second turn, gave way in the drive. DREXEL MONORAIL failed to menace. TOOK OUT was never involved.
