Footnotes

CHERRY PINK stalked for six furlongs, challenge in the second turn, kicked clear, kept to task in the late going to prevail. LUMINAIRE MYSTIQUE lacked speed, steadied briefly in the second turn, moved out to be four wide turning for home, finished up willingly. MISSY MINER dwelt at the start, raced back off the inside, advanced along the rail in the second turn, closest to the winner a furlong out, flattened out a bit in the late going. COUGAR NIGHT off the pace, moved closer four wide in the second turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. CLASSIC GAIT saved ground early while outrun, angled out four wide turning for home, lacked a late kick. HIGH FAITH sprinted clear to set the pace, faltered when headed late in the final turn. SMOOTH SEA chased for five furlongs, gave way. NORTHEAST HARBOR gave way after a half.
